
Dear Parents,

In this Sunday's Gospel, Peter asks Jesus the question about how many times we should forgive. Jesus' answer shows that we must forgive one another just as God forgives us: again and again, without limit. Forgiveness is the lifeblood of any family or community.

Now as this servant went out, he happened to meet a fellow servant who owed him a very small amount of money; but he would not cancel the debt but instead had the poor servant arrested. When the news reached the king, he sent the unforgiving servant to prison to be punished."



#### PE Kit

### **Social Media sites**

There have been a number of reports on the news this week about disturbing and inappropriate videos and messages on sites such as TikTok. We have also heard that some children in school have their own YouTube channels and Roblox accounts. Please ensure that you are aware and are monitoring your child's use of the internet.

### For your reference:

- ➤ TikTok requires that users be at least 13 years old to use the full TikTok experience, although there is a way for younger kids to access the app. Anyone under the age of 18 must have approval of a parent or guardian -- but there are plenty of young tween users.
- ➤ WhatsApp minimum age of use is **16 years old** if you live in the European Union, or a country that has adopted the GDPR, as the UK has.
- ➤ You can register for a YouTube account from the **age of 13** in the UK. Because YouTube is owned by Google, the site uses a Google accounts sign-in system to give you access to all their products such as YouTube, Gmail and Google+.
- Roblox is an online game and app suitable for **ages 7 and above** where you can create your own games or play games that other users have made. There's the option to chat to other players which means that ESafety is extremely important.
