This has certainly been a challenging week for all members of our school community and I thank you all for your continued support and compassion

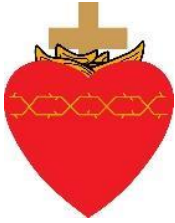

We hope you are all keeping well and looking after each other and your families.

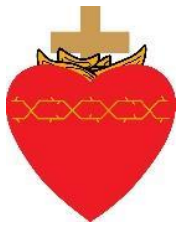

keep going - you've got this!

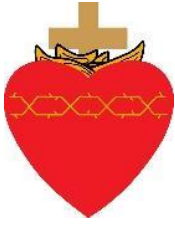
