Science

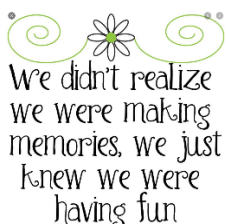
This week's Science is some revision work to see what you can remember about your learning on rocks, soils and plants.

Reading

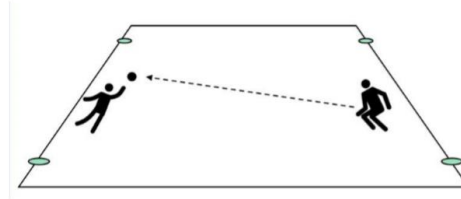
Read the text called 'Apollo and Chimera'.
